MAINTAINING HEALTHY FEET WITH DIABETES

Some illnesses are detrimental to the healthy functioning of the feet. The most prominent illness that is known to cause foot problems is diabetes.

It is important that all diabetics have an annual foot care check with a podiatrist. In between annual checks, SEC Care can provide assistance and guidance for the healthy functioning of diabetic feet.

The SEC Care Foot Clinic is located at 12 Somerville Street, Sorell. The Clinic is run by qualified staff who provide quality foot care.
