SEC Care's Community Transport Service is available for the use of attending non-urgent medical appointments.

## HOW TO REGISTER FOR COMMUNITY TRANSPORT

To enquire or register for SEC Care's Community Transport Service, phone our reception on (03) 6269 1200 to arrange for a registration form.

## TRANSPORT AVAILABILITY

SEC Care's Community Transport Service is available between 8:30am and 5:00pm, Monday – Friday for non urgent medical appointments in either the local area or to specialist appointments in the Hobart, Clarence or Glenorchy regions.

## HOW TO BOOK TRANSPORT

Once registered for SEC Care's Community Transport Service, transport requests can be booked by phoning our reception (03) 6269 1200 between 9:00am and 4:00pm, Monday – Friday.

## PLEASE NOTE

Every effort will be made to provide transport for you on day and time requested. However, it may not always be possible, as this service is subject to the availability of our dedicated volunteer drivers.

Please note that this is not an on-call service and we require two business days notice to arrange transport. In the event of a medical emergency an ambulance should be called by phoning 000.

## FEES

A current Fees Schedule, detailing relevant fees may be obtained by request. Fees may be revised from time to time by SEC Care, in accordance with operational requirements and cost increases – clients will be advised accordingly.
